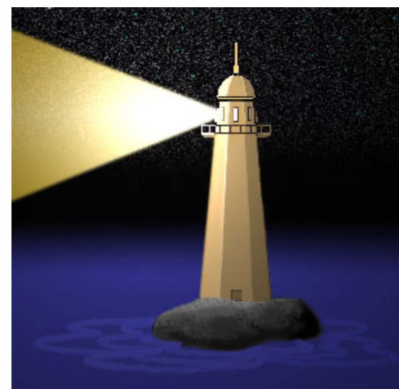


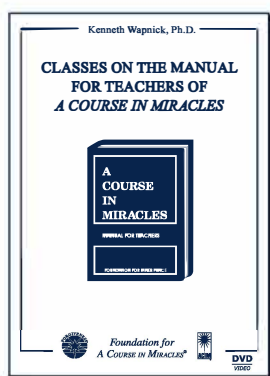

Reflecting the structure of symphonic compositions, these classes are organized around the two major themes appearing in the manual for teachers, along with their variations and subsidiary themes. The line-by-line commentary presented in each class shows the masterful way in which Jesus weaves together his basic message, in this form of themes and variations. The first major theme in the manual is that of *separate versus shared interests*, which evolves from the larger theme permeating the entire Course, of the oneness of God's Son and His perfect unity with His Creator and Source. The second and equally important theme is that of *asking the Holy Spirit for help*, which is central to the process of understanding and integrating the principles of *A Course in Miracles* into one's daily life, and without which one cannot transcend the self-centered perception of separate interests, nor truly become a teacher of God.

Her Struggle as Our Struggle

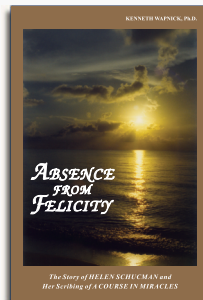
Kenneth's intimate relationship with Helen Schucman, during the eight years following her scribing of the Course until her death, gave Kenneth a unique awareness of her ongoing struggle with the source of the material, Jesus, as well as with the Course's personally challenging message of forgiveness. Ken over the years has written and spoken in great depth about Helen's ambivalent relationship with both Jesus and the Course as she fluctuated between resistance to Jesus and his message and willingness to be his scribe and student.

Kenneth's sharing of personal details of Helen's relationships is never simply to tell a story, but rather to illustrate dynamics of the process with the Course that can help its students recognize that Helen's struggle parallels our struggle between the wrong mind and the right mind—even though the forms of our lives may look quite different from hers. The content of the struggle remains the same. And so we too can learn from her experience to accept that Jesus' love for all of us is not conditional, but is reflected in a patience and understanding that transcends any worldly love.
